VOLUNTEER OF THE YEAR AWARD

ATTORNEY GENERAL LYNN FITCH

2023 Recipient

MARGIE MONTGOMERY VALOR AWARD

Lynn Fitch was sworn in as Mississippi's 40th Attorney General and first ever woman Attorney General on January 9, 2020. AG Fitch and her legal team defended Mississippi's abortion restrictions and are responsible for *Dobbs v Jackson Women's Health Organization*, the landmark decision that resulted in *Roe v. Wade* being overturned! Fitch has argued that a ban on abortion would empower women and that abortion prevents women from reaching their full potential

Raised in Holly Springs, Mississippi, AG Fitch earned both a Bachelor of Business Administration and a Juris Doctorate at the University of Mississippi. At the age of 23, she began her legal career as a Special Assistant Attorney General at the Mississippi Attorney General's Office. She continued her career in private practice as a bond lawyer, accumulating more than 35 years of legal experience both in private practice and public service.

Before becoming the State's chief legal officer, AG Fitch served as Mississippi's elected State Treasurer for eight years, from January 2012 to January 2020. Prior to that, she was selected by Governor Barbour to serve as Executive Director of the Mississippi State Personnel Board (MSPB), and she served as Deputy Executive Director at the Mississippi Department of Employment Security (MDES) and as Counsel for the Mississippi House of Representatives Ways and Means and Local and Private Legislation Committees.

In 2022, TIME named AG Fitch to its list of the 100 most influential people in the world and Worth Magazine named her to its Worthy 100 for her work protecting women and children. AG Fitch has also been active in her community, serving as a member of the boards of several charitable organizations including First Responders of Mississippi, the Juvenile Diabetes Research Foundation, Goodwill Industries, and the American Red Cross.

Right to Life has successfully advocated for the following legislation in Kentucky:

- 1. State Funding (1978) No state funds to be used for abortion
- 2. Insurance Coverage (1978) No insurance policies cover abortion except by payment of additional premium
- 3. Use of Public Facilities (1980) No public facilities to be used for abortion
- 4. Public Funding (1980) No public funds to be used for abortion
- Agency Regulations (1978) Penalties for any agency receiving kickback fees for abortion referrals
- Informed Consent for pregnant women (1984) (Enjoined in Eubanks v. Brown (1984)
- 7. Parental-Judicial Consent (1986) Requires minor seeking abortion to receive consent from parent, or in limited circumstances, a judge
- 8. Defeat of Living Will (1976-1988) (Unfortunately, Kentucky now has a Living Will and Health Care Directive Law) Defeat of amendment to remove food and hydration provision from Living Will (1992)
- 9. Parental-Judicial Consent (1994)
- 10. Anti-Assisted Suicide (1994) Prohibits assisted suicide or euthanasia
- 11. Informed Consent (1998) (A Woman's Right to Know) Requires that the abortionist offer complete information about patient risk, fetal development and alternatives to abortion, and requires a 24-hour period of reflection before procuring abortion
- Abortion Clinic Regulations (1998) Requires that minimum standards be maintained in the performance of abortion
- 13. Partial-Birth Abortion Ban (1998) Struck down by Sixth Circuit Court of Appeals
- 14. Fetal Homicide (2004) Considers a baby in utero from conception onward to be second victim in any criminal homicide that harms or kills the unborn child
- 15. Amendment to 1998 Informed Consent Law (2016) Mandates a face-to-face meeting with a physician, or a health care professional whom he delegates, at least 24-hours prior to the abortion. This eliminates the telephonic pre-recorded message that had been used since 1998.
- 16. Ultrasound informed consent (2017) Requires abortion providers to perform, display, and explain an obstetric ultrasound prior to a woman consenting to abortion in Kentucky.
- 17. Pain Capable Unborn Child Protection Act (2017) Prohibits abortion past 20-weeks gestation to protect unborn children from feeling excruciating pain during the procedure.
- 18. Defunding Planned Parenthood (2017) Prohibits use of local or state tax-payer funds for abortion, and redirects federal tax money away from organizations that perform abortions and prioritizes funding to health agencies that do not.
- 19. Protecting Unborn Children from Dismemberment Abortion (2018)
- 20. Web-Cam Abortions Prohibited (2018)
- Clarification of definitions used in legislation, including abortions and abortion reporting (2020)
- 22. Born Alive Bill, providing for treatment of any infant born alive, including after a failed abortion (2021)





Position Statement ABORTION EXCEPTIONS

Right to Life of Louisville restates unequivocally that it is opposed to all abortion and respects all human life from fertilization to birth to natural death. Abortion destroys an innocent life.

If the rare situation arises when a mother's life is endangered, then her physician/ obstetrician should do all he or she can to save both the life of the mother and the life of her unborn child.

Pregnancies from rape, which are rare, and incest are not reasons for allowing abortion. Abortion in cases of incest hides the crime of incest, which continues to hold the female victim in bondage to the secrecy of the molestation.

If pregnancy results from rape or incest, the woman should be given the support she needs to carry her pregnancy to term, have the baby, and, if unable to care for the child herself, then place the baby in the loving arms of adoptive parents.

Though some may say it is a grave injustice to ask a woman who conceives through rape to bear a child she does not want, it is an even greater injustice to destroy an innocent human life. We believe that all lives are precious in God's eyes regardless of the circumstances surrounding his/her conception. To do violence to the unborn child will not undo the violence already done to the mother.

The woman, who has been violently attacked, should be given medical attention, love, and support in the wake of this trauma and not be prompted to undergo additional trauma from abortion, which has its own physical and emotional complications.

To allow abortion as an acceptable medical procedure and a solution to a social problem would result in no logical barrier to abortion on demand. Only by finding positive solutions to unplanned pregnancies will we truly foster a life-affirming culture in our world today and in the future.
