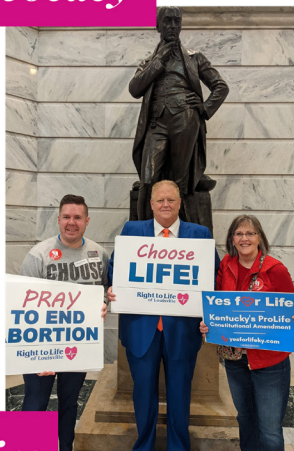

VOLUNTEER OF THE YEAR AWARD

Upon listening to a homily by Father Joseph Hamilton in early 1973 regarding future consequences *Roe* would impose on the sanctity of life, Mary Ann immediately signed on to be a part of the first prolife group at St. Stephen Martyr parish.

Mary Ann's continued involvement throughout the years led her to be an active prolife leader at the parish level and a co-chair of the committee. St. Stephen Respect Life Ministry involves parishioner support of numerous prolife endeavors annually. Also, Mary Ann considers it a privilege to organize the Rosary Rally and Patriotic Rosary in honor of our Blessed Mother Mary.

In early 1990, Mary Ann accepted a position to serve on the Right to Life Board of Directors. She chaired the High School Oratory Contest for many years and accompanied our state winner to the National Contest. During her tenure in this role, a Kentucky student was a semifinalist in the competition and another student was the national winner! What an honor to accompany and coach them on their journey.

Mary Ann has served as President of Right to Life of Louisville and has undertaken multiple responsibilities throughout the years. Most recently she guided the organization through a revision of its bylaws. She is quick to jump in whenever a need arises, and is methodical in completing the task. She currently sits on the Board as President Emeritus.

On a personal note, Mary Ann is married to the love of her life, Bob, and is blessed with four children and seven grandchildren. Life is good!



ATTORNEY GENERAL LYNN FITCH

2023 Recipient

MARGIE MONTGOMERY VALOR AWARD

Lynn Fitch was sworn in as Mississippi's 40th Attorney General and first ever woman Attorney General on January 9, 2020. AG Fitch and her legal team defended Mississippi's abortion restrictions and are responsible for *Dobbs v Jackson Women's Health Organization*, the landmark decision that resulted in *Roe v. Wade* being overturned! Fitch has argued that a ban on abortion would empower women and that abortion prevents women from reaching their full potential

Raised in Holly Springs, Mississippi, AG Fitch earned both a Bachelor of Business Administration and a Juris Doctorate at the University of Mississippi. At the age of 23, she began her legal career as a Special Assistant Attorney General at the Mississippi Attorney General's Office. She continued her career in private practice as a bond lawyer, accumulating more than 35 years of legal experience both in private practice and public service.

Before becoming the State's chief legal officer, AG Fitch served as Mississippi's elected State Treasurer for eight years, from January 2012 to January 2020. Prior to that, she was selected by Governor Barbour to serve as Executive Director of the Mississippi State Personnel Board (MSPB), and she served as Deputy Executive Director at the Mississippi Department of Employment Security (MDES) and as Counsel for the Mississippi House of Representatives Ways and Means and Local and Private Legislation Committees.

In 2022, TIME named AG Fitch to its list of the 100 most influential people in the world and Worth Magazine named her to its Worthy 100 for her work protecting women and children. AG Fitch has also been active in her community, serving as a member of the boards of several charitable organizations including First Responders of Mississippi, the Juvenile Diabetes Research Foundation, Goodwill Industries, and the American Red Cross.

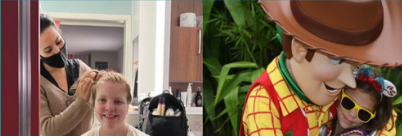

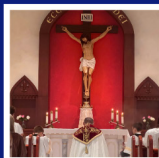
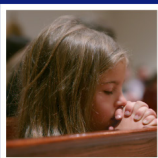

Position Statement *on* ABORTION EXCEPTIONS

Right to Life of Louisville restates unequivocally that it is opposed to all abortion and respects all human life from fertilization to birth to natural death. Abortion destroys an innocent life.

If the rare situation arises when a mother's life is endangered, then her physician/obstetrician should do all he or she can to save both the life of the mother and the life of her unborn child.

Pregnancies from rape, which are rare, and incest are not reasons for allowing abortion. Abortion in cases of incest hides the crime of incest, which continues to hold the female victim in bondage to the secrecy of the molestation.

If pregnancy results from rape or incest, the woman should be given the support she needs to carry her pregnancy to term, have the baby, and, if unable to care for the child herself, then place the baby in the loving arms of adoptive parents.

Though some may say it is a grave injustice to ask a woman who conceives through rape to bear a child she does not want, it is an even greater injustice to destroy an innocent human life. We believe that all lives are precious in God's eyes regardless of the circumstances surrounding his/her conception. To do violence to the unborn child will not undo the violence already done to the mother.

The woman, who has been violently attacked, should be given medical attention, love, and support in the wake of this trauma and not be prompted to undergo additional trauma from abortion, which has its own physical and emotional complications.

To allow abortion as an acceptable medical procedure and a solution to a social problem would result in no logical barrier to abortion on demand. Only by finding positive solutions to unplanned pregnancies will we truly foster a life-affirming culture in our world today and in the future.

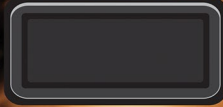
